Course Requirements:

English classes are designed for the purpose of fulfilling the requirements of the Shasta Union High School District English/Language Arts Curriculum. To that end the following are required:

1. Every student reads everyday (SSR). The first 20 minutes of class time will be spent reading materials selected by the student. Daily reading logs and sharing about materials read are required. Students are required to bring (maybe kept in class) reading materials to be used on a daily basis.

2. DOL- each student is responsible for completing the Daily Oral Language –daily. The completed assignments are to be kept in student binders and turned in on Friday of each week.

3. On a weekly basis students will be required to complete a vocabulary development unit and assessment.

4. Depending upon the session and its length, the class will be completing a novel, from start to finish. Assignments will be given based upon the novel’s theme and issues being discussed.

5. Students will be given periodic opportunities to earn extra credit. At a minimum students may complete a reading log outside of class (12 hours of reading = 1 credit).
