

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Algebra 1A

During the course of the school year the following topics will be covered: understanding expressions and equation, operations with integers, solving both linear and quadratic equations, radicals, and graphing linear and quadratic equations. This material corresponds to chapters 1-7 in the algebra one textbook.

1. MATERIALS NEEDED

- A. Pen or Pencil
- B. Paper

2. TESTS

- A. There will be a test given upon the completion of each chapter.

3. QUIZZES

- A. There will be one quiz given during each chapter.

4. HOMEWORK

- A. Done on an extra credit basis only.

5. GRADING POLICY

- A. Students will earn a daily grade of up to 10 points for each day they attend class. Half the points are determined by the quality of the work done. The other half is determined by behavior.
- B. Final class grade will be determined by simple percentage determined by how many points are earned on tests, quizzes, and the daily grades.

6. GRADING SYSTEM

- 90-100 percent A
- 80-89 percent B
- 70-79 percent C
- 60- 69 percent D
- below 60 percent F

7. CREDIT SYSTEM

- A. One credit will be earned for every twelve productive days. Student must earn at least six points a day to be considered a productive day.
- B. Students can earn extra credit for work done out of class. The extra credit cannot exceed the amount of credit earned in class.
- C. Students can earn a maximum of five credits each grading period. On the average the grading period is thirty school days.
